

2010 SUMMER SKEET LEAGUE

BILLINGS ROD & GUN CLUB

The 2010 Summer Skeet League begins **Tuesday, June 1 2010** and runs for 8 weeks on Tuesday nights. The league will be limited to 12 teams. Shooters will shoot **50 targets each week** for a total of 400 targets.

The league will consist of **5 man teams. This year no new shooter is required.** New shooters will be allowed to shoot singles rather than doubles at stations 1,2,6&7 until they score 15 or more in a round. A new shooter is defined as someone 1) who has not previously shot a summer skeet league or 2) who is 16 years of age or younger.

Shooting times and fields will be pre-assigned on a rotating schedule of 45 minute flights and 4 fields. Teams not able to make their scheduled time need to make arrangements with another team or league management.

League fees are due the first night* of shooting and will be used for awards:

Individual fee: \$15.00 Team sponsor fee: \$30.00 Non-member gate card fee: \$20.00

League target fees: Adults: \$9.00 / 50 targets Kids (18 and younger): \$7.00 / 50 targets

Individuals who pull for another team will receive a card good for a free line of skeet card.

Shooters wishing to pay on a weekly basis will owe both the individual fee of \$15 and the first week's target fees (\$9.00/adults or \$7.00/kids) on June 7, then target fees only for 7 more weeks.

Shooters can purchase a **league punch card** that pays for the league in one lump sum the first night of the league only*. **The cost of a card for adults is \$87.00, for kids \$71.00.**

Individuals will be handicapped to the score of 47 after 50 targets (week 1). Handicaps will be adjusted after week 3 and again after week 5. Shooters may use their handicap to score up to 49 but must shoot 50 scratch to score 50. Handicap scores will be used in the team scores only. **Teams will use its top 4 handicap scores each week** (or the first 4 scores turned in if missing scores are not shot ahead) in its cumulative team score. High team score out of 1600 will be declared team champion. Second place team and those teams' sponsors will also be awarded. Ties will be decided by shoot-off.

Individuals will be assigned a class based on average of scratch scores after 250 targets (or after week 5) using Lewis class system. **An individual's lowest score in the 8 weeks will be dropped.** First and second place in class will be awarded based on high scratch scores out of 350 targets. Special awards will be given to junior, lady, most improved and sportsman. Other awards may be added. Ties will be decided by shoot-off.

Make up scores or scores shot ahead will be allowed provided 1) scores are turned in on a dated scoresheet, 2) lines are paid for at league rates, 3) scores for weeks 1-5 are shot by week 5, and 4) scores for weeks 6-8 are shot by week 8. See team and individual rules on dropping low scores (or zero scores). Shooters may be required to re-establish average if a larger gauge is shot than what was used to establish average.

Rules may be modified to accommodate league situations.

***Preregistration will be offered on Sunday, May 30th, for those wanting to avoid the rush.**

The League Banquet will be held Saturday, July 24th . More information on the banquet and championship will be handed out at a later date.

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ADDITIONAL LEAGUE INFORMATION

1. **THE 2010 SUMMER SKEET LEAGUE RUNS FOR 8 WEEKS, JUNE 1st THROUGH July 20th.** Make up scores for weeks 1-5 must be in by June 29th (5th week)
2. **MAKE SURE EACH OF YOUR TEAMMATES HAS A COPY OF THE TIME/FIELD SCHEDULE.** Each team has 45 minutes to complete 2 rounds. Start shooting on time! If you are waiting for a team to finish on your field and they don't have a puller, offer to pull for them, if a puller is not available, but it looks like we will be well covered all summer
3. **ENCOURAGE YOUR TEAMMATES TO PULL FOR OTHER TEAMS. ANYONE DOING SO WILL BE GIVEN A CARD GOOD FOR ONE LINE OF SKEET.**
4. **ALL SHOOTERS NEED TO SIGN UP EACH WEEK AND PAY OR PUNCH IN ORDER TO GET THE TOKENS FOR SHOOTING.** This applies to Sunday shooting also.
5. **ENCOURAGE YOUR TEAMMATES TO SHOOT AHEAD RATHER THAN TRY TO MAKE UP FOR MISSED WEEKS.** Each Tuesday after shooting ends, we will use the top 4 handicap scores to calculate your team score. If a score is shot ahead, it will be considered in choosing the top 4 scores. However, if there are only 4 scores shot for that week by Tuesday night, the other score shot in the weeks following will only be used for individual scoring, not for team score. If this isn't clear, ask someone to explain it to you.
6. **SHOOT AHEAD SCORES AND MAKE UP SCORES CAN BE SHOT ON SUNDAYS OR WITH ANOTHER TEAM ON TUESDAYS IF THEY HAVE A SHORT SQUAD OR IF THERE IS AN OPEN FIELD.** (field 4 will be open to shoot ahead or make up on Tuesday nights)
7. **SCORES WILL BE POSTED IN THE ORDER THEY ARE SHOT.** This is especially important if you are shooting ahead or making up. However, if you are shooting in week 4 but are missing a score for week 3, your score will be used for week 3 unless you are making up week 3 that same night. If you are shooting ahead knowing you will be gone in a future week, your score will be posted in the next open week, not in the week you will be gone. In most cases, though, scores will be posted in the order shot.
8. **NEW HANDICAPS WILL BE ESTABLISHED AFTER WEEK 1, WEEK 3 AND WEEK 5.** This is easier to do if all scores are current so shoot ahead whenever possible. See the rules on handicaps and ask if you have questions on them.
9. **NEW SHOOTERS CAN SHOOT SINGLES FOR DOUBLES AT STATIONS 1,2,6,7 UNTIL THEY SCORE 15 OR HIGHER IN A ROUND.** At stations 6 and 7, they should shoot High-Low then Low-High so they are shooting their second set of singles in doubles order.
10. **CHECK YOUR TEAM'S SCORES AT THE END OF EACH NIGHT.** You don't have to post your own scores but it wouldn't hurt to double check to see if they are posted correctly.
11. **ENJOY THE LEAGUE!** Not everyone can win but everyone can have a good time!
