First Night is Thursday April 8th

General Info on the Sporting Clays Spring/Summer League

The 2010 Spring/Summer League will be on Thursday evenings and run for 12 weeks starting on April 8th and ending on June 24th. Fun Shoot and Awards Dinner will take place on July 1st. League is limited to the first 72 shooters that register. Registration Fees are \$20 per person and teams may range from 3 to 6 shooters. All registration fees will go toward league prizes and dinner. Nightly target fees are the same as last year - \$20 per 100 targets.

Team Structure

New for this year, we are encouraging every team to recruit at least one new shooter to your team as we will have six person teams. As an incentive, the new shooter that has never shot sporting clays will have an added handicap of 2 targets. All new teams that have never shot sporting clays will have a special award.

Though teams may have between 3 and 6 shooters, only the top three scores will count for each night.

Alternate shooters are permitted at any time, but only their raw (non-handicapped) score will be counted unless they shoot 3 or more nights. Shooters must start between 4:30 and 5:30 PM each Thursday evening. No make-up days are allowed due to the drastically ever-changing wind conditions and trap setting changes. However, only your team's top 8 scores out of 12 nights will be counted, -- so you can miss 4 nights without penalty.

Shooter Handicap

All shooters will be given a handicap after the seventh night of shooting based on the average of 3 nights of shooting. The 3 weeks to be utilized for handicapping will be chosen by picking numbers out of hat. This will keep anyone from dogging it to get a higher handicap. All shooters scores will be handicapped to 92. For example if you shoot an average of 70 on the 3 chosen evenings, you will be given a handicap of 22 for each night of the league. When a shooter shoots above a 92 the raw score will be counted.

Dinner and Social Hour after Shooting

Each night after shooting hamburgers will be prepared by the nightly "Grill Cook" for your dining pleasure.

Each team is asked to cook one Thursday and the top chef award will be presented at the awards dinner. Also, please check the "I Want Dinner List" at the front desk when you check in before shooting. Cost of dinner will be minimal, --just enough to cover costs. Please pay for this at the same time you pay the nightly shooting fees. Beverages will be available for donation.

Awards

Awards Dinner and Fun Shoot will take place on July 1st. Team awards prizes will be presented at the league dinner to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams as well as the top NEW shooter team. In addition individual awards will be given to: 1)Top overall shooter - raw score; 2)Top overall shooter – handicapped; 3)Top woman shooter; 4)Top senior - over 70; 5)Top junior – under 18; 6)Top sub-gauge shooter – separate handicap system;
