



**Billings Rod & Gun Club
Concept Master Plan**
October 2009



- 1 Main Clubhouse**
The Main Clubhouse is not changed, however, the west Target Archery range has been moved which provides space for a Club Picnic Grounds. The Caretaker's house has been slightly expanded and a private yard area has been created to assure better privacy. Also, the Main Clubhouse parking lot has been expanded to the south due to the reconfiguration of the Caretaker's yard.
- 2 Office & Indoor Archery**
A non-gated visitor parking lot has been created east of the current entry for the new Club office; and in the future it can be expanded for the new indoor archery hunter education building. This is made possible by moving the west Target Archery range to the north.
- 3 Target Archery**
A new Target Archery range has been created adjacent to the existing Sporting Clays clubhouse. This clubhouse will become the Archery Clubhouse since Sporting Clays will be moving to the north. The new Target Archery range area is much larger and safer than the existing locations.
- 4 Field Archery**
The Field Archery range remains in the same location; however, the road and parking area adjacent to the existing skeet fields has been modified and expanded. This change along with stricter observance of the 40 yard safety zone may cause the relocation of a few existing target butt locations.
- 5 Sporting Clays**
The Sporting Clays range has been partially relocated to the north to eliminate several safety conflicts. It will occupy the existing skeet clubhouse. The current road alignment next to the skeet clubhouse has been moved to the north to lessen the steep slope and move the road out of the parking lot.
- 6 Rifle Range**
The existing Rifle Range will stay in its current location; however, some safety improvements will be made. These improvements include proper wall and berm containment on the sides of the 100 yard range. And, in the future, baffling will be constructed on the 100 yard range if road and building development commences to the north.
- 7 Pistol Range**
The existing Pistol Range will stay in its current location; however, the range will be expanded about 50' to the west and in the future three fifty foot wide pistol bays will be added to the east. This expansion is possible due to moving Skeet Field five to the east. Future plans also include larger berms, safety fencing, adequate ready and safe gun handling areas and gated entry.
- 8 Skeet Range**
A new Skeet Field area will be built east of the existing Pistol Range. It will have five fields that allow for Trap Field overlays with a northerly orientation. A new Clubhouse and two target storage sheds will be built along with adequate parking and road access.
- 9 Club RV Parking**
A Club RV parking area with electrical hookups has been provided adjacent to the Skeet Range. It provides nine pull-through spaces that will allow for up to 18 RV's under 60' in length.
- 10 Dog Training Fields**
Three new fenced dog training fields have been created within the current farmed wheat field areas south and east of the new Skeet Fields. These areas do not conflict with any of the gun range safety zones. This conversion of farmed ground to native grasses will allow dog training by up to three individuals at one time. A parking area has been provided on the easterly end of the RV Park.
